Why Liability Insurance?

Because no matter how careful you are, accidents happen. And you can be sued by anyone who claims injury or damages resulting from your activities. You may not be liable, but you will need to be defended in court. A liability policy will pay for this defence as well as any costs awarded against you. In short, liability insurance gives you peace of mind.

Who is Insured?

All members of your organization, including players, executives, managers, coaches, trainers, officials, employees and volunteers while acting within the scope of their duties on your behalf.

Activities Covered

Sanctioned or authorized events & fundraisers, including related training authorized by you.

Host Liquor Liability Coverage available upon request.

General Liability Insurance

The policy will pay those sums that the insured becomes legally obligated to pay as compensatory damages because of bodily injury to or damage to property of others, such as spectators, passersby, property owners and others resulting from your operations or actions. Coverage includes your legal liability for injury to participants

Limit - \$2,000,000 Aggregate

Including the following extensions:

- Premises, Property and Operations
- Products and Completed Operations
- Blanket Contractual
- Personal Injury (libel and slander)
- Employees as Additional Insured
- Cross Liability
- Non-Owned Automobile - \$1,000,000
- Tenants Legal Liability - \$250,000

THIS IS AN ANNUAL POLICY – DECEMBER 1, 2006 TO DECEMBER 1, 2007

Includes tryouts, practices, all tournaments your team may attend in Canada or the USA during the entire year, you do not need a special policy if your team decides to hold a practice, go for a skate or play in a 3 on 3 tournament.

A reimbursement deductible of \$1,000 applies to bodily injury, property damage and legal expenses.

Special Policy Features:

Canadian teams can have US players on their roster provided US players have Visitors to Canada sports medical coverage in order to play

Canadian teams playing in US tournaments are covered for liability. ALL players must carry out of country sports medical coverage in order to play in out of country tournaments.

If you wish to purchase out of country sports medical coverage, we can provide the following rates:

US Players playing in Canada - \$2.30 per person per day - \$50,000 benefit limit.

\$3.30 per person per day \$100,000 benefit Limit

Canadian Players playing in US - \$1.75 per person per day - \$2,000,000 benefit limit.

Coverage must be purchased prior to departure.

NO MORE CHARGE FOR HOSTING TOURNAMENTS

- We will provide coverage for your hosted tournament(s) including volunteers, coordinators, etc.
- You must ensure that every team that participates in your tournament provides proof of liability coverage prior to playing in their first game.
